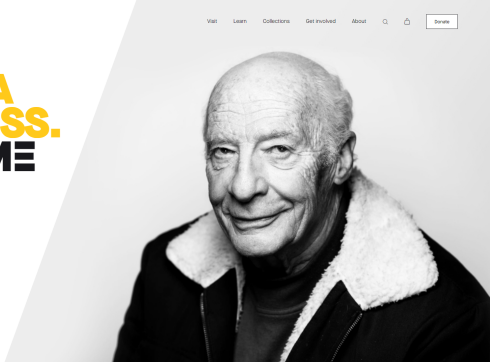


HEAR A WITNESS. BECOME ONE.
